

SHBP Copay/ Coinsurance Waiver Program



Disease management pharmacy copay/coinsurance waiver program for Wellness HRA and Wellness HMO Plan options

The State Health Benefit Plan (SHBP) disease management pharmacy copay/coinsurance waiver program is offered to encourage active participation in the Well Aware programs for better health. We believe offering disease related drugs at no customer cost share will foster healthy behavior changes among individuals.

Who is eligible for this program?

This program is available to all customers enrolled in a Cigna **SHBP** Wellness Open Access Plus-In Network (OAPIN) (HMO) option or **SHBP** Wellness Choice Fund HRA option who actively participate in the Cigna Well Aware programs for asthma, cardiac or diabetes. Customers enrolled in the **Standard** OAPIN and Standard HRA options are **NOT** eligible.

How do I enroll in one of the Cigna Well Aware programs for asthma, cardiac or diabetes?

If you are not currently enrolled in Well Aware and have a confirmed diagnosis of asthma, coronary artery disease or diabetes, please call 1.866.635.8942 to request enrollment.

What is considered "active participation" in one of the Well Aware programs?

Active participation is defined as engaging in three telephone sessions with a Well Aware nurse within a

rolling six month period. Upon completion of the first call, the SHBP member will become eligible to receive specific drugs (as listed below) at no customer cost share.

How soon will the pharmacy copay/coinsurance waiver begin after my initial telephone session with a Cigna Well Aware nurse?

Eligibility is provided around the 25th day of each month to Cigna pharmacy to update/add customer information. It generally takes up to six weeks for the waiver information to be loaded in Cigna's pharmacy system.

What happens if I no longer actively participate in the Well Aware programs?

If you do not engage in three telephone sessions with a Well Aware nurse within a rolling six month period, your pharmacy copay/coinsurance waiver will be removed from our pharmacy claim system and you will be responsible for your cost share in accordance with your plan's pharmacy benefit.
