Despite having the same basic health needs as the general population, LGBTQ+ individuals can experience health disparities and barriers because of their sexual orientation and/or gender identity or expression. Because of this, many avoid or delay care, or receive inappropriate or inferior care.*

- This information is important to meet the demand of the health care needs of the underserved LGBTQ+ community and reduce the health disparities one person at a time.


What does success look like for health care providers and our customers?
