

Cigna Earns Top Marks in 2017 Corporate Equality Index for 5th Consecutive Year

This is the fifth year in a row that Cigna has scored highly on the CEI, and joins the ranks of 517 major U.S. businesses that also earned top marks this year.

The 2017 CEI rated 1,043 businesses in the report, which evaluates LGBT-related policies and practices including non-discrimination workplace protections, domestic partner benefits, transgender-inclusive health care benefits, competency programs, and public engagement with the LGBT community. Cigna's efforts in satisfying all of the CEI's criteria results in a 100 percent ranking and the designation as a Best Place to Work for LGBT Equality.
