Beginning December 15, 2016

What's changing?

Beginning December 15, 2016,* Samsca will be covered as a specialty medication on Cigna's Prescription Drug List. Samsca is used to treat hyponatremia, or low sodium levels in the body.

Also, to closely monitor the use of this medication, Samsca's manufacturer has chosen to limit its supply to only a few pharmacies in the United States. We want you to know that Cigna Specialty Pharmacy ServicesSM is one of those pharmacies, and can fill the medication for you.**

What should you do if you're taking Samsca?

- Talk with your doctor about this change.

* In accordance with Texas and Louisiana state law, customers with affected benefit plans who receive coverage for medications that are removed from the prescription drug list during the plan year will continue to have those medications covered at the same benefit level until their plan renewal date. To find out if these state mandates apply to your plan, please call Customer Service.

**Not all plans include Cigna Specialty Pharmacy Services. Health plans vary, but in general to be eligible for coverage a drug must be approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), prescribed by a health care professional, purchased from a licensed pharmacy and medically necessary. If you use a pharmacy that does not participate in your plan's network, your prescription may not be covered, or reimbursement may be limited by your plan's copayment, coinsurance or deductible requirements. Refer to your plan documents for costs and complete details of your plan's prescription drug coverage.



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
