# 1 | About this Plan

**Cigna Fundamental Medicare (HMO)** covers Part B drugs including chemotherapy and some drugs administered by your provider; however, this plan does not cover Part D prescription drugs.

## 2 | Monthly Premium, Deductible and Limits

Monthly Premium	<b>\$0</b> per month. In addition, you must keep paying your Medicare Part B premium. Cigna will reduce your Medicare Part B premium by <b>\$40</b> .

Is there any limit on how much I will pay for my covered services?	<p>Original Medicare does not have annual limits on out-of-pocket costs.</p> <p>Your yearly limit(s) in this plan:  <b>\$6,700</b> for services you receive from in-network providers for Medicare-covered benefits.</p> <p>This limit is the most you pay for copays, coinsurance and other costs for Medicare services for the year. If you reach the limit on out-of-pocket costs, you will keep getting in-network covered hospital and medical services and we will pay the full cost for the rest of the year.</p> <p>Please note that you will still need to pay your monthly premiums.</p>
