


Narcotics Anonymous

Motivation to change by working the twelve steps of NA.


Identity - creating a positive sense of self - deconstruct and rebuild. Positive behavioral change by practicing the spiritual principles of the NA program.



2018 Membership Survey

- Members surveyed averaged 2.25 meetings per week
- The average length of cleantime in NA is 8.86 years

Quality-of-Life Improvement Areas Multiple answers were allowed




In times of Covid-19

When the Covid-19 pandemic broke out thousands of NA-meetings were closed from one day to another.

NA-members feared that isolation and the closing of meetings would cause a wave of relapses.

And that addicts seeking recovery would lose the possibility to find hope and a new way of life in NA.
